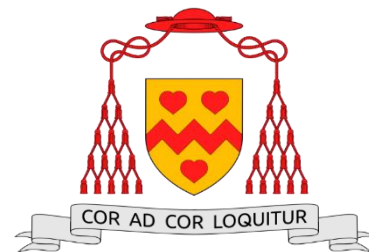

May to June 'Primary Teacher and Secondary School Liaison'

June 5 – June 9 Pupil Information Questionnaire - Important
