The school receives an activity survey from INSPIRA each year to give us an up-to-date indication of destinations data showing where our students moved on in their next steps.

Our destinations data is shown to be consistently secure with high numbers of students successfully transitioning to suitable next steps. We compare incredibly favourably with county data with a significant proportion of our students securing Sixth Form and FE places.

Our Sixth Form participation figures are steady, with an increase indicated in the most recent survey data.

Where students are identified as NEET, our Careers Advisor offers further follow-up meetings with the students in order to try to continue to promote the importance of post-16 engagement.

23% of this cohort moved onto Sixth Form education.

63% of this cohort moved onto Further Education.

12% of the cohort participated in full time training or apprenticeships.

Year 13
